The Arkansas Department of Agriculture's Forestry Division is offering the Arkansas Foresters for the Future Scholarship to a high school senior. The Arkansas Foresters for the Future Scholarship is intended to provide educational support to individuals identified as capable and motivated to pursue a career in forestry. This scholarship provides recipients with support through four years of higher education in an accredited forestry program, subject to continuing eligibility requirements. Students will have the opportunity to participate in paid internships with the Forestry Division

Instructions to Applicant: To apply for the AFF Scholarship, you must be accepted as full-time, first-time freshman at the University of Arkansas at Monticello pursuing a forestry education.

Application Requirements:

- Application form
- High school transcript/Homeschool transcript/GED
- ACT or other standardized placement exam scores
- Provide a letter (1-2 pages) describing your interest in a forestry career, include any special circumstances that might qualify you for this scholarship
- Provide a letter of reference, in a sealed envelope, from a current/previous high school teacher, principal or other professional affiliate
- List any scholastic awards, honorary awards, extracurricular activities, or public and professional associations which may qualify you for scholarship consideration.

The applicants will be reviewed by the Arkansas Foresters for the Future Scholarship Committee consisting of representatives from the Arkansas Department of Agriculture's Forestry Division and the University of Arkansas at Monticello College of Forestry, Agriculture and Natural Resources. Academic progress reports will be sent to the committee at the end of each semester. Grade point average and full-time enrollment status will be evaluated in the determination of continuing eligibility.
