**USE of ALL IM/REC FACILITIES ARE LIMITED to UAM STUDENTS/FACULTY & STAFF. PERSONS RESERVING THE PAVILION & SAND VOLLEYBALL COURTS AGREE TO ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING AND ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR INFORMING ALL USERS DURING THE RESERVATION OF THE PERTINENT RULES:**

The following Terms of Use Policies are IN ADDITION TO University Facility Reservations Terms of Use and Policies.

- The University Advisor or their approved faculty/staff designee\*, must be **visibly present in the immediate vicinity during the entire reservation**. \*The name and contact number of the advisor or approved UAM faculty/staff designee must be submitted to IM/Rec Director prior to event. For camps, this person must be a full-time adult employee of the camp/institute.
- Use of facilities during reservation is limited to organization members and current UAM students, faculty & staff, as warranted unless special approval received. NOTE: During camp reservations, use is limited to actual camp members and approved camp personnel only.
- As with any recreation area, care and caution should be exercised at all times. All users are encouraged to consult a physician for a health check-up prior to use of any rec area. Balls are to be used for their intended purposes only – balls are not to be thrown at the lights or pavilion. Appropriate attire, behavior and language are required.
- Requests for sports equipment must be submitted with reservation. Not all requests may be met. All IM/Rec equipment must be checked-out from the UC Rec ID Desk Attendant prior to end of business each day, Monday – Thursday. The equipment must be returned at the end of the reservation or prior to 8:30am the next working day. Individuals &/or groups will be required to reimburse the university for any damage.
- Requests for all other university equipment made by completing appropriate section of School Dude Reservation Request.
- **Planning to serve food?** Campus contract requires contacting Aramark Food Service **(870)460-1076**, prior to any event on campus.
- Bleachers are not to be moved.
- No glass containers are permitted in this area.
- Pets are not allowed in and around the courts.
- All sand is to remain in the courts.
- Do not pull or hang on the SVB nets.
- Good sportsmanship is expected to be exhibited at all times.
- It is highly recommended that personal items such as wallets, cell phones and other electronic devices not be brought to this area. If brought, they should not be left unattended.
- Advisor and Organization Officers must ensure that the pavilion and sand volleyball courts are **used appropriately** and are neat upon departure. Trash should be placed in appropriate receptacles. **TRASH INVOLVING FOOD, SHOULD NEVER BE LEFT OVERNIGHT-TAKE TO DUMPSTER located at university apartments.**
- Individuals &/or groups will be required to reimburse the university for any damage.
- Report any problems promptly to University Police Department, **(870)460-1000**.
- **Failure to comply with any of these policies/procedures and/or all other university rules and student code of conduct will result in loss of reservation privileges. Additional action may also be taken.**

#### **UAM IS A SMOKE FREE CAMPUS.**

Smoking (including eCigarettes) is prohibited on all University owned or leased property. Please note “university property” includes but is not limited to: “buildings, facilities, sidewalks, roadways, parking lots, athletic fields and grounds.” This also includes personal vehicles parked on University property. As a reminder, the cost for violating this state law can include a municipal fine up to \$500. The policy includes not only faculty, staff and students but also any visitor to the UAM campus.

#### **ALCOHOL AND ILLICIT DRUGS ARE PROHIBITED**

UAM strictly prohibits the dispensing, selling, supplying, possession, use, manufacture, or distribution of alcohol or illicit drugs on University owned/University controlled property. Students found to be in violation of the alcohol and illicit drug policies are subject to arrest, criminal prosecution, imprisonment, and/or fine according to state and federal law.
