
The Arkansas Timber Harvest Report displays Arkansas timber severance tax data as reported from the Arkansas Department of Finance and Administration. Timber severance taxes are collected, reported, and remitted by each primary processor of Arkansas timber. It is computed based on the weight determined the last time timber is weighed prior to undergoing the first primary processing after severance. Severance totals can be submitted one of three ways: monthly (by the 25th day of the following month), quarterly, or annually. Reporting time frame varies by primary processor. 

TIMBER HARVEST TRENDS

In the second quarter of 2024, Arkansas reported a total timber severance of 4.9 million tons, representing a 6% decrease compared to the previous year. The largest decline was observed in non-pine wood, which decreased by 8% statewide year/year.

In North Arkansas, severance of non-pine species fell by 17% year/year. In South Arkansas, changes were more modest, with a 5% decrease in pine wood and an 8% decrease in non-pine species compared to the same period last year.

From January 1, 2024, to the close of the second quarter, the timber severance in the state totaled over 9.7 million tons.
