

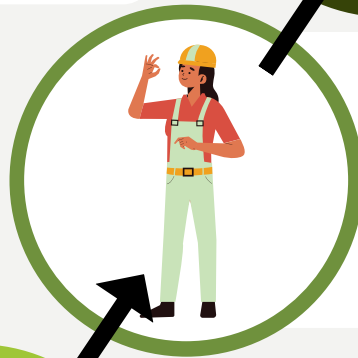
FOREST ECONOMY
