HEALTH PROFESSIONS

Program Description

The Health Professions Technical Certificate is designed to provide successful students with instruction that assists in mastery of core knowledge and skills to provide the foundation for various health professions. Students exiting the program with a technical certificate in Health Professions may go directly into the healthcare support workforce as nursing assistants, emergency medical technicians, community health workers or phlebotomists (depending on emphasis chosen); or continue on for advanced training and education. Graduates of the Health Professions program may continue to pursue an Associate of Applied Science Degree in General Technology.

The program costs and length of this program will vary based on sufficient demand for class offerings and the emphasis chosen.
