When You Arrive...

CHECK – IN: 9AM - 12PM

Check-in is from 9:00 to 12:00 at Horsfall Hall, across the street from the Gibson University Center. You will be greeted by counselors that will give you your key and room assignment. You may unpack your belonging for the week and get settled into your rooms. **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP UP WITH YOUR KEY DURING THE WEEK.** Please be sure you lock your dorm room **EVERY TIME** you exit the room.

***Please pay any balance that is owed on your account in the Ball Hall, which is located in the Visual and Performing Arts Building.

***Please let us know at check-in if you require medications taken daily at a certain time!

-QR Codes will be provided with the schedule to cut down on paper waste. This schedule will be available for parents to scan as well so you will be in the loop.

-A Remind 101 will be in place for students (and parents) to sign up for so you can receive announcements (standard text message rates apply).

-Access to UAM's wireless internet (wifi) will not be available to campers, therefore, please make necessary arrangements.

LUNCH AND DINNER

At 12pm, please meet in the Green Room (room with green carpet) of the University Center, located on the west side of the campus (follow signs or ask counselors for assistance). With the exception of lunch on the first day, meals will be served at the cafeteria on campus daily (lunch on the day of check-in will be on your own). Be sure you wear your lanyard and name tag daily so there will be no charge. We will break for each meal together and leave from the cafeteria as a group.

All campers must be checked out of their dorm room **PRIOR** the Exhibition Performance

EXHIBITION PERFORMANCE—Friday, July 15

The last day of camp, the students will perform in camp exhibitions, displaying the mastery and skill of a choreographed routine taught earlier in the week. Please invite your band directors and parents to attend the performance!!!
