When You Arrive...

CHECK – IN: 11AM – 2PM

All students should check in to the band hall upon arrival. The band hall is located in the Visual and Performing Arts Center (VPAC) The addresses to all buildings on campus are provided at the bottom of this letter.

-QR Codes will be provided with the schedule to cut down on paper waste. This schedule will be available for parents to scan as well so you will be in the loop.

-A Remind 101 will be in place for students (and parents) to sign up for so you can receive announcements (standard text message rates apply).

-Access to UAM's wireless internet (wifi) will not be available to campers, therefore, please make necessary arrangements.

The following will take place at check in:

You will be issued a key to the room that you will be staying in.

This will be returned at the end of camp! If a key is lost, it will cost \$75 to replace.

You will receive a lanyard and button that you can keep your room key on.

This will be the way you will be admitted to the dining hall!

You will receive a schedule of events for the week.

AUDITIONS: 12PM – 3PM

IMMEDIATELY after you check in, you may take your things to your assigned room, then it's time to audition for your chair placement. There will be signs posted and counselors to help you find the specific building and room you'll be in for auditions.
