**ARRIVAL DAY**

***Check – in:*** 11AM – 2PM

- Upon arrival, all students will check in to their assigned dorm. Dorm assignments will be sent via email sometime the week before camp begins. The addresses to all campus buildings are provided at the bottom of this letter.
- Upon check-in, students will be issued the following:
  - o A key to the room that you will be staying in. This will be returned at the end of camp! You will be charged \$75 to replace a lost or damaged key.
  - o A lanyard/nametag upon which you may choose to keep your room key. This nametag will also allow you access to the dining hall!
  - o A daily schedule for the week



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***Please Note:***

- The first meal provided for all campers is dinner on Tuesday. The last meal provided is lunch on Saturday. If you would like to eat lunch with your camper before Saturday's concert, you must purchase a meal in the cafeteria.
- Campers are not provided access to UAM Campus Wi-Fi

**DEPARTURE DAY**

***Check Out:*** Parents/guardians should plan to arrive on campus prior to the start of the concert to assist their camper pack and check-out. UAM will not provide storage for personal items during the concert. All campers must be checked out of their room PRIOR to their concert.

Concerts will be on the last day of camp at the Fine Arts Center Auditorium on the UAM campus. Concerts begin at 12:30pm.
