Bachelor's Degree Rules:

For the BSN degree (120 hours), ADHE requires 40 upper-level credits and 35 credits (lower) be general education core courses. Also, 30 credits must be UAM residency; 20 of those 30 credits must be upper level in nursing; and experiential credit does not count toward the 30-hour residency requirements.

Credit Breakdown

AS/BSN Gen Ed = 30 credits
ASN courses = 36 credits (escrow)
Nutrition experiential credit (or taken) = 3 credits
Additional BSN Gen-ed = 24 credits
BSN courses = 27 credits
Total = 120 credits

Upper level = 63 credits (36 credits from escrow and 27 credits from BSN courses)

Lower level = 54 credits (30 credits from AS/BSN Gen ed and 24 credits from additional BSN Gen-ed)

Residency = 30 credits

Upper level = 27 credits from BSN courses (20 required)
