Arkansas Natural and Cultural Resources Council (ANCRC)—Business Meeting Taylor House

Prior to the UAM Taylor House dedication, the ANCRC will conduct their business meeting, which is open to the public. The ANCRC was established by the Arkansas Legislature in 1987 by Arkansas Act 729 and was created to manage and supervise a grants-and-trust fund for the acquisition, management and stewardship of state-owned properties acquired or used for ANCRC-approved purposes. The grants are funded through the state's real estate transfer tax. The ANCRC consists of eleven voting members. Grants from this fund are for projects that protect and maintain state-owned natural areas, historic sites and outdoor recreation.

UAM's most recently acquired historic property is the former home of the Taylor family, which once was part of the Hollywood Plantation. Over a five-year span, the ANCRC has provided UAM with grant funds totaling \$2,282,500 for the property to be restored to its original grandeur. The Taylor House is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Members of the UAM History faculty have been a part of the restoration process and will be available to discuss the building's unique architectural significance. The ceremony will also serve as the debut of an archeology exhibit put together by UAM's station archeologist on the investigations conducted at the property over the past 30 years.
